Table 1 (Below) shows that Corruption Perception Index (CPI) Rankings of India and Maldives of 2022-2023 and 2024 are same and has gone down from 85 to 93 and then 96, respectively whereas that of China are lower being 65, 76 and 76. But that of other neighbours Nepal, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Bangladesh are higher than that of CPI of India.

Corruption Perceptions Index (CPI)

The Corruption Perceptions Index (CPI) is an Index that Scores and Ranks Countries by their perceived levels of Public Sector Corruption, as assessed by experts and business executives. The CPI generally defines corruption as an "Abuse of entrusted Power for Private Gain". The Index is published annually by the non-governmental organisation Transparency International since 1995.

Rescaling Source Data

In order for all data to be aggregated into the CPI index, it is first necessary to carry out standardization during which all data points are converted to a scale of 0-100. Here, 0 represents the most corruption and 100 signifies the least. Indices originally measuring Corruption inversely (Higher Values for Higher Corruption) are multiplied by -1 to align with the 0-100 scale.
